Standards for Temporary Exhibits in the Barn Gallery at Ladew Topiary Gardens

In furtherance of the spirit of the late Harvey S. Ladew, the Trustees of Ladew Topiary Gardens have created a “Barn Gallery” on the property at 3535 Jarrettsville Pike, Monkton. It is hoped that the Barn Gallery will act as a catalyst and magnet for the artistic community, attracting shows and exhibits of high quality in many diverse media: this, too, is in keeping with the spirit of Harvey Ladew, a life-long amateur painter, sculptor, and photographer, to cite three of his many avocations.
